OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 09-128 (Extension of Executive Order 08-101)

WHEREAS, by Executive Order 08-101, the Governor recognized the continued partnership with the Florida Sterling Council as a partner with the state to promote organizational performance excellence through increased awareness of organizational performance excellence management best practices, methods, techniques, including performance-based processes to improve service delivery, customer service, managing new ideas and a focus on accountability and results; and

WHEREAS, the partnership between the Executive Office of the Governor and the Florida Sterling Council shall expire on May 28, 2009, unless extended by amendment.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, CHARLIE CRIST, Governor of Florida, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the constitution and laws of the State of Florida, issue the following executive order:

Section 1.

Executive Order 08-101 is hereby extended until January 5, 2011, or until such earlier time as this Executive Order is amended or rescinded by further executive order of the Governor.
