The Summit features a **Florida Team Showcase** winner, the City of Tallahassee Underground Utilities and Public Infrastructure "Infrastructure Innovators" team. Their project focused ensuring stakeholder safety and convenience and infrastructure cost avoidance are critical priorities within strategic objectives for Underground Utilities & Public Infrastructure (UU&PI). UU&PI's projects focused on improving infrastructure maintenance of sidewalks to eliminate falls and trips and roadway repaving using technology to prioritize the condition assessments and to avoid road expensive decay. Using leadership, innovative strategies, the customer's voice, improved processes, technology, and workforce dedication, UU&PI has successfully achieved the project goals. Through increased fiduciary support, process improvements, and better analysis tools that have avoided costs, this prevented injuries and accidents to stakeholders from sidewalk usage and initiated a holistic pavement management process. UU&PI successfully improved the roadway pavement processes by 197% over 3 years and reduced sidewalk claims paid by \$114,400 over 4 years.
